- * Judith Jones and Bill McGowan have volunteered to serve one extra year.
- ** Margaret Johnson is planning to retire in 2002. Her replacement would be appointed for a full four-year term instead of just finishing Margaret's last year.
- *** We are proposing the addition of an ANREP representative who would begin his/her four-year appointment in 11/01.
- **** Ken Bateman was appointed in 2001 and is willing to serve either a one- or two-year term to facilitate the rotation. That position would then begin with a four-year appointment in 11/01 or 11/02. If the ANREP representative is approved, Ken's term would end in 11/02. If the ANREP representative is not approved, Ken's term would end in 11/01.
- ***** Keith Niemann originally had a three-year appointment (under the previous rotation) and is serving an extra year as past chair during the transition time. He will not be replaced.
